Corey was an exceptional student at South High, excelling in debate and carrying a 4.0 grade point average. She planned to pursue a career in medicine, and was a volunteer at the NICU at Providence Hospital.

Corey was one of the most accomplished debaters in South High School history. She was named the 2008/2009 MVP of the South Anchorage HS DDF team, and was elected to become the team Interpretation Captain for the 2010/2011 season. She had most recently achieved 1<sup>st</sup> place overall (with teammate Bexley Brown) and 2<sup>nd</sup> best speaker in British Parliamentary Debate at the 2010 Northern Lights Tournament at the University of Alaska Anchorage. Her list of accomplishments was impressive, including:

- Advanced to quarterfinals of the 2010 Alaska State DDF Championship tournament in Lincoln Douglas Debate
- Qualified to the 2010 national championship tournament in Dramatic Performance and Duo Interpretation
